




## Planning and Technical Services – Cost-Share


- PAS
  - 50% Federal
  - 50% Non-Federal
  - Up to \$455,000 Cost-share Waiver for Tribes
- FPMS
  - Can be up to 100% Federally Funded
  - Dependent on Funding Availability
  - Non-Federal Funds Can be Used to Expand Scope




